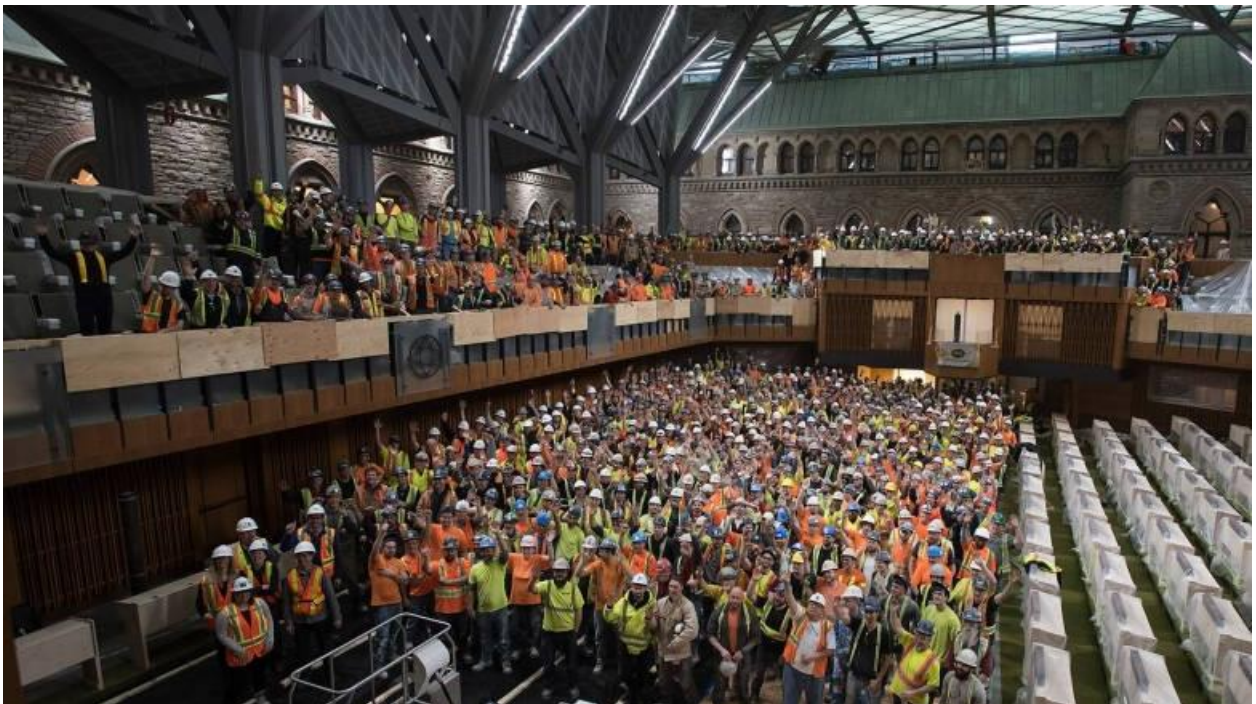
Technical Site Tour – Wednesday, October 24, 2018, 9 AM.

***The Glass Roof of Parliament
The Site Tour***



In April of this year BECOR hosted a luncheon technical seminar on the new glass roof over the temporary House of Commons in the West Block. Presentation included speakers from ARCOP/FGM joint venture architectural firms, Front Inc., designers of the roofing and envelope systems, PCL General Contractors Canada Inc, and The Seele Group of Companies. The presentations were so well received that when attendees were asked how many would like to attend a site visit to see first hand the new facilities, we had an almost 100% response, plus a “sold out tour” and requests for another opportunity.





In light of this response, BECOR, in conjunction with ARCOP/FGM, site architects, would like to announce that we have received approval to host a second site visit to the new temporary House of Commons zone in the West Block building. With building handover to the Speaker of the House in progress, this tour will not be quite the same as the first tour, in that we can no longer access the “attic” directly below the glass roof. However, it will be another amazing tour nonetheless.

There will be a 24 person limit for this tour. Registration will be taken on a first come first serve basis for BECOR members only. A site orientation session will be mandatory prior to the site visit. Please show up 15 minutes early. Late attendees will not be allowed on the tour.

While many previous attendees said that they would love to go again, since space is limited, this tour is reserved for those not attending the first tour.
