The Decline of Modified Bitumen Roofing: How to Extend the Life Cycle of Existing Roofs

This situation results from a combination of improper materials chosen in the design, extreme weather and poor quality workmanship. This presentation will review specific case studies in the Ottawa region and provide an alternate solution to restore these roofs rather than perform a full replacement; thereby extending roof life and reducing land fill waste.
